### **READ AND WRITE LIKE A DETECTIVE**

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Inspired by The Ministry of Unladylike Activity By Robin Stevens

- Solve puzzles as Robin Stevens reveals curious clues about the plot of, *The Ministry of Unladylike Activity*, and tells us what she found out about life for children during WW2



### The Artist


In the show, Ed Vere introduces us to his book The Artist. The book reminds us that making mistakes shouldn't stop us from creating and sharing our art with the world.






### Your inner artist

Ed encourages us to see the world as an artist and share what we have imagined and seen. Use this Doodle Dinosaur to draw what is fizzing and bumping around in your head.






### What is an Artist?






