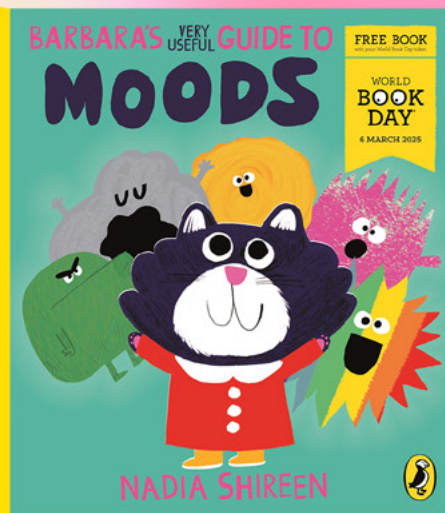

A DICTIONARY OF CHARACTERS

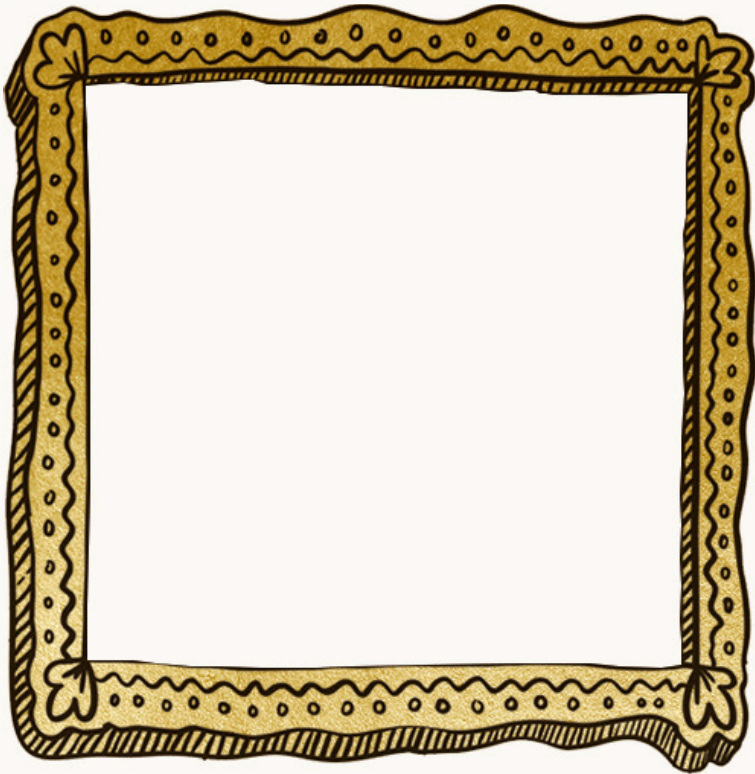
Inspired by: *The Swifts* by Beth Lincoln

Atrocious-	<i>(adjective)</i> Horrifyingly wicked
Barbaric -	<i>(adjective)</i> Savagely cruel, unsophisticated.
Covetous -	<i>(adjective)</i> Greedy, eagerly desirous.
Dither -	<i>(verb)</i> To be indecisive
Eerie -	<i>(adjective)</i> Strange, creepy or unsettling
Fumble -	<i>(verb)</i> To drop, to hold clumsily, or to make a mistake
Gumption -	<i>(noun)</i> Courage, moxie, determination
Hirsute -	<i>(adjective)</i> Hairy!
Inheritance -	<i>(noun)</i> A thing that is inherited
Jollity -	<i>(noun)</i> Lively and cheerful activity
Ken -	<i>(verb)</i> To know or understand
Lollygagger -	<i>(noun)</i> A person who lollygags– they waste time by doing things that aren't useful.
Maudlin -	<i>(adjective)</i> Tearfully sentimental, dramatically sad
Needle -	<i>(noun)</i> A thin metal rod used in sewing / <i>(verb)</i> to provoke or insult
Oddball -	<i>(noun)</i> An unusual person; someone who doesn't fit in
Persnickety -	<i>(adjective)</i> Placing too much emphasis on trivial or minor details; fussy.
Querulous -	<i>(adjective)</i> Complaining in a whining voice
Rumpus -	<i>(noun)</i> A noisy disturbance; a row.
Serpentine -	<i>(adjective)</i> Winding or snake-like
Temerity -	<i>(noun)</i> Excessive confidence or boldness; audacity.
Uncouth -	<i>(adjective)</i> Lacking good manners, refinement, or grace.
Vespine -	<i>(adjective)</i> Resembling a wasp
Wonderment -	<i>(noun)</i> Astonishment or surprise
Xenolith -	<i>(noun)</i> A rock trapped inside lava (this one is hard, okay?)
Yonder -	<i>(adjective)</i> Distant, far away
Zealous -	<i>(adjective)</i> Showing great energy or enthusiasm in pursuit of a cause or objective.

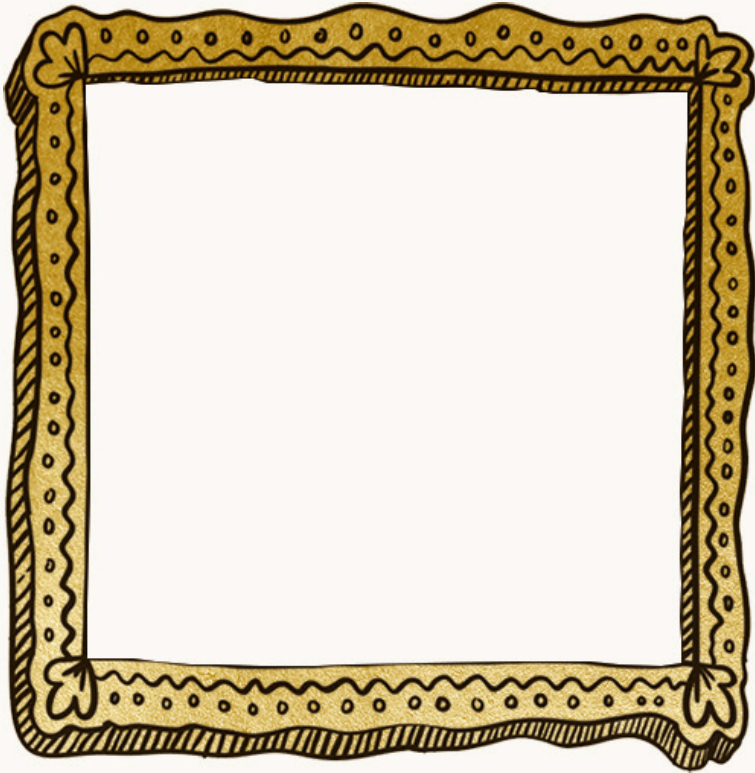
